1. Food & Water

- Provide high quality, nutritious foods
- Clean water every day

2. Shelter

- A warm or cool place to stay safe from outside elements
- This may also include a Crate, Kennel, Bed, and Cat Tree

3. Identification

- This includes I.D. Tags, Collar, Microchip, and County License
- For safety, keep your pups on a Leash and Harness when in public.





4. Exercise

- Proper exercise allows your pets to stay fit keeping their bodies and minds sharp
- Potty Walks are ideal as an exercise both you and your pet benefit from them
- Make sure to be responsible bring your Poop Bags to clean up after you pet! And don't forget those Litter Boxes for cats & bunnies!

5. Yearly Vet Check-Ups

- Keeping up on your pet's health is important
- Yearly check-ups will help keep your pet's Vaccinations up-to-date
- Your Veterinarian can keep an eye on your pet's Dental Hygiene and provide pest prevention -Flea & Tick Medication

6. Spay & Neuter

- This is a surgery your Veterinarian will perform to keep your pets from having babies

7. Grooming

- Keeping your pets clean can help with their overall health - reducing exposure to germs - who wants a smelly dog?!?
- Grooming includes Baths, Brushing, and Nail
